

Accessing the RACC Wifi network.

Wireless access to RACC Network resources (home area, shared areas, etc.) is now available using the college owned laptops, from anywhere within the college buildings. You can also access the Internet from your own phones, laptops and other wifi devices using the “RACC-Guest” wireless network.

Access is available to all Staff and Students, with a valid RACC network account, and to external Guests who will need to obtain a login from IT Services, for the day required.

Please note: You are bound by the **acceptable use policy** when using the college wireless access, which is available to view via the RACC website (intranet page) and Moodle VLE.

Guest Access Instructions

Note: BEFORE connecting please ensure that your device has the latest updates installed, and is running up to date antivirus software.

From your Wifi enabled device connect to the advertised “RACC-Guest” wireless network.

Open a web browser e.g. Internet Explorer, a portal page should open asking for authentication details – See the screenshot below.

Type in your RACC login id and password, in the appropriate boxes provided.
